

MAY 24, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 17th, 1940, and recessed until May 24th, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

The following written protests on the establishment of Local Improvement District No. 19 as per notice published May 10th, 12th and 13th, 1940, were read:

“To the City Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls:

I hereby protest on all legal grounds against establishing proposed improvement district number 19, or the making of the improvements referred to in resolution number one on file in your office. This protest is filed with you pursuant to the notice of intention to establish local improvement district number 19 published in the Post-Register on May 10, 1940.

The following applications for rooming house licenses were read: Cotton Rooms, Rex Rooms, Nippon Rooms, New Oxford Hotel, M & K Rooms, Park Rooms. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed the following plumbers to act as a Plumbing examining board with Herman Drewes, Water Works Sup't: Earl Harris, A. O. Miller, Freeman Hansen, Leonard D. Sautter; and also appointed Herman Drewes as Plumbing Inspector. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the appointments be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise the caretakers house at Highland Park for sale. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wasley, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
