

MAY 17, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 17th, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans. Absent: Wasley. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING THE SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 534 AND NO. 535 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Sutton, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: Brandl. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: Brandl. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: Brandl. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT NO WATER SHALL BE FURNISHED BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS TO A USER OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS UNLESS A PERMIT THEREFORE IS FIRST OBTAINED FROM THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL: PROVIDING THAT THE USER SHALL PAY THE COST OF INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION AND SHALL FURNISH A METER AND METER BOX FOR MEASURING SAID WATER: AND PROVIDING A MONTHLY CHARGE TO BE PAID BY SUCH CONSUMER" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitle: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF MENAGERIES, CIRCUSES AND CARNIVALS AND FIXING THE LICENSE FEE TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE: REPEALING SECTIONS 250 AND 252 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Sutton, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the meeting recess until May 24th, 1940, at eight o'clock P.M. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.
