

MARCH 15, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held March 15<sup>th</sup>, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Fanning, that the Post-Register be paid \$28.00 for listing the city buildings and parks, etc. in their new business and professional directory. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Brandl, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed Mrs. D. F. Richards as a member of the Public Library Board to fill the unexpired term of Frank E. McClure, deceased. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the appointment be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, William W. Keefer, was one of the early pioneers of the Snake River Valley, and lived a long and useful life among us; and,

WHEREAS, he unselfishly devoted four years of his time as councilman of the Fourth Ward of the City of Idaho Falls to the progress and betterment of the City; and,

WHEREAS, we have lost a valued member of our community;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, in meeting assembled, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1940, that our expression of profound regret be recorded and sincerest condolences and sympathy be extended to his bereaved family, and that a copy of this resolution be delivered to the family, a copy by given to the press and a copy spread upon the Clerk's minutes of the City of Idaho Falls."

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the permits be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The following petition, signed by thirty people who live on Cassia Avenue, was read:

“Idaho Falls, Hyland Park, Idaho.

Greetings:

We, the undersigned, residents of Idaho Falls, respectfully petition the Honorable Chairman, Chase A. Clark, and Councilmen to cause to have removed from city limits of this community the Stock Buyers corrells located about 932, 935 Cassis St., on both sides of street. It being unsanitary in this residential district.”

The Mayor referred the petition to the Sanitary Inspector.

The following petition was read:

The Mayor referred the petition to the Water and Light committee.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: DESCRIBING SAID LANDS, AND DECLARING THE SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS.", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans. Voting nay: Brandl, Crabtree, Fanning, Wasley. The vote being equally divided, the Mayor cast his vote "Aye".

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its third reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: Brandl, Fanning, Wasley, Crabtree. The vote being equally divided, the Mayor cast his vote "Aye".

The ordinance was then numbered 535 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 535 was passed and approved on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1940, annexing certain land therein described to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and it appearing that it is not necessary at this time to survey said land as provided by Sec. 49-304 Idaho Code Annotated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said land shall not be surveyed until the further order of the City Council, but that the Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls shall duly certify to a copy of said ordinance under the corporate seal of the City of Idaho Falls and immediately file said certified copy of said Ordinance with the County Recorder of Bonneville County, Idaho."

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Sutton, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

At this time the Mayor turned the meeting over to Councilman Fanning, president of the Council.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
