An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF GLADSTONE STREET IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Voting nay: None. Absent: Crabtree and Gourley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Fanning, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Absent: Gourley and Crabtree. Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 534 was passed and approved by the 8th day of March, 1940, annexing certain land therein described to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and it appearing that it is not necessary at this time to survey said land as provided by Sec. 49-304 Idaho Code Annotated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said land shall not be surveyed until the further order of the City Council but that the Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls shall duly certify to a copy of said Ordinance under the corporate seal of the City of Idaho Falls and immediately file said certified copy of said Ordinance with the County Recorder of Bonneville County, Idaho."
