

SEPTEMBER 15, 1939

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 15th, 1939.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; councilmen: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Absent: Mehlhoff and Gourley. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read:

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the permits be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 778 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS PROVIDING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR PLUMBING AND SEWER PERMITS AND A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR INSPECTION OF PLUMBING AND SEWER WORK" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Wasley, Evans. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 525 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE 471 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS PROVIDING FOR THE EXPIRATION OF JOURNEYMEN PLUMBERS' LICENSES AND FOR RENEWAL THEREOF AND FIXING THE FEE FOR SUCH RENEWAL", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Evans, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONDEMNATION BY THE PLUMBING INSPECTOR OF DANGEROUS, UNSAFE AND UNSANITARY PLUMBING, AND FOR NOTICE TO THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE BUILDING IN WHICH SUCH PLUMBING IS SITUATED TO REPAIR OR REMOVED SAME, AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR SUCH PERSON TO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH SUCH NOTICE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 527 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING WILLIAM J. VAIL, AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING PASSENGER BUSES: REQUIRING THE FILING OF ROUTE SCHEDULES WITH THE CITY CLERK: PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM FARE TO BE CHARGED: PROVIDING FOR THE CLASS OF SERVICE TO BE GIVEN, PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF SUITABLE PARKING PLACES AND FOR GENERAL REGULATION OF SAID BUSES BY THE CITY COUNCIL", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance not be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: Sutton. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be authorized to order 68,000# of re-enforcing steel, and 31,000# of structural steel, terms to be on payment of \$1500.00 per month. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the City pay David Johnson \$25.00 for his electric line east of 11th Street, when J. A. Wilkinson pays this amount, when he connects on to the Johnson line. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Absent: Mehlhoff and Gourley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Evans, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Absent: Gourley and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.
