TAKE NOTICE:

Evidence having been submitted to the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho that you are operating a disreputable place of business where disturbances have frequently occurred, and that you have not properly controlled and regulated your place of business so as to operate it in an orderly and lawful manner:

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED to appear before the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, at the council room in the City Building in Idaho Falls, Idaho, on Friday, the 18th day of August, 1939, at eight o'clock in the evening, and then and there show cause, if any you have, why your license as a retailer of beer in the City of Idaho Falls, should not be revoked.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 778 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, PROVIDING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR PLUMBING AND SEWER PERMITS AND A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR INSPECTION OF PLUMBING AND SEWER WORK" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF THE PLUMBING INSPECTOR OF DANGEROUS, UNSAFE AND UNSANITARY PLUMBING, AND FOR NOTICE TO THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE BUILDING IN WHICH SUCH PLUMBING IS SITUATED TO REPAIR OR REMOVE SAME, AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR SUCH PERSON TO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH SUCH NOTICE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed the following committee to make the necessary amendments to the Bus Ordinance, and present same for the final reading September 1st, 1939.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Idaho Falls Animal Products Company be disconnected from the storm sewer one week from today if they don't make the necessary sanitary corrections at their plant and change their connection on to the sewer as they were instructed to do by the Sanitary Inspector and Water Works Superintendent. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
