The following letter was read:

“To the Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Gentlemen:

I am the owner of the following described property:

Commencing at the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (which is also described as Lot 2 of Sec. 30 in Tp.w N.R. 38 E.B.M. in Bonneville County, Idaho) and running thence North along the West

line of said section 472 feet, thence East 507 feet, thence South 472 feet, thence West along the south line of said quarter-section 500 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5.45 acres, more or less, all in Bonneville County, Idaho.

This being located between that ten acre tract recently purchased by the City for cemetery purposes and the north line of the City Park.

I understand that the City contemplates extending its boundaries as I do not wish this property to be taken within the limits of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, I hereby protest the extension of the City boundaries so as to include this property within the City limits of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING WILLIAM J. VAIL, AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING PASSENGER BUSES: REQUIRING THE FILING OF ROUTE SCHEDULES WITH THE CITY CLERK: PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM FARE TO BE CHARGED: PROVIDING FOR THE CLASS OF SERVICE TO BE GIVEN: PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF SUITABLE PARKING PLACES AND FOR GENERAL REGULATION OF SAID BUSES BY THE CITY COUNCIL" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Evans, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Absent: Gourley.
