

JULY 21, 1939

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held July 21st, 1939.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting and of special meeting held July 12th, 1939, were read and approved.

The following applications for Soft Drink licenses were read:

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

C. R. Crowley appeared before the council as a representative of the property owners on Lee Avenue between 14th and 15th Street, and requested the city to take action against J. L. Grimmett to compel him to move his planing mill. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that the City Attorney be authorized to start a condemnation suit as counsel for C. R. Crowley and other residents to compel J. L. Grimmett to move his planing mill from the corner of 15th Street and Lee Avenue. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Sutton, that the Electric Light Committee and Finance Committee be authorized to purchase a generator and switch boards for power plant No. 4, and the Mayor be authorized to sign the contracts covering the equipment purchased. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that the Mayor be authorized to notify the War Mothers that the city has reserved the southwest room in the Armory Building for their headquarters. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The Mayor referred the petition for the Street & Alley Committee.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING WILLIAM J. VAIL, AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING PASSENGER BUSES: REQUIRING THE FILING OF ROUTE SCHEDULES WITH THE CITY CLERK: PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM FARE TO BE CHARGED: PROVIDING FOR THE CLASS OF SERVICE TO BE GIVEN: PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF SUITABLE PARKING PLACES AND FOR GENERAL REGULATION OF SAID BUSES BY THE CITY COUNCIL" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 455 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS SECTION 455-a PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: PROVIDING A SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE INSPECTION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING AND EQUIPMENT AND THE INSTALLATION THEREOF: AND REPEALING SECTION 450 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS AND ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Evans, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 524 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Evans, that the city donate \$100.00 to the Boy Scouts. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

Claim for damage on fender on his Mercury car in the amount of \$4.00 signed by Wm. S. Holden was read. The City Street Department wagon ran into the above car.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the claim for \$4.00 be allowed and paid. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Brandl, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
