"That the Owners apply to the Regional Director of the Public Works Administration for a reduction in the scope of the above mentioned project, namely: That the funds set up for Contract No. 3, Equipment in the amount of \$7,500.00 and funds for Architects' fees in the amount of \$1,875.00 be transferred to Contract No. 2, Construction. Necessary funds for equipment and architects' fees have been provided in the City's budget for the year 1939.
