

JANUARY 20, 1939

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Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 20<sup>th</sup>, 1939.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen: Fanning, Gourley, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing. Absent: Mehlhoff, Evans. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for licenses were read:

Soft Drink - Fred Chappell  
Rooming House - Ross Hotel  
Nelson Hotel  
Manhattan Rooms  
Cutter Hotel.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Wing, that the licenses be granted. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Wasley, Crabtree, Wing, Sutton, Fanning. Absent: Mehlhoff and Evans. Motion carried.

Contract agreement covering heating equipment to be installed in the Social Aid Building by D. G. Sautter and Sons was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Fanning, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the agreement. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley. Absent: Mehlhoff and Evans. Motion carried.

A letter from the Commissioner of Reclamation advising the city that proof of completion of works on water filing Permit No. 17252 had not been made in November, 1938, and the permit would be cancelled forty days from date, was read. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Crabtree, that the matter be referred to the Mayor with authority to sign a relinquishment to the State of Idaho covering filing under permit No. 17252. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley. Absent: Evans and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

The following bid on Lot 1, Block 61 of the Original Townsite was read:

The Corporation of the L. D. S. Church submits a bid of \$281.91 for Lot 1, in Block 61 Original Townsite.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wing, that the bid be accepted. Roll Call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley. Absent: Evans and Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

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The following bids for heating equipment for the Armory Building were received but not opened:

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that bids for heating equipment on Armory Building be submitted to local dealers and plumbers for a bid, and all bids will be opened February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1939. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley. Absent: Mehlhoff and Evans. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wing, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley, Sutton. Absent: Mehlhoff and Evans. Motion carried.
