Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 6<sup>th</sup>, 1939, and recessed until January 13<sup>th</sup>, 1939.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 18, FOR THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO: APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR SAID DISTRICT AS FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK ON OCTOBER 13<sup>TH</sup>, 1938, AND ACCEPTED AND CONFIRMED BY THE COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 28<sup>TH</sup>, 1938, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT IN INSTALLMENTS FOR THE COST AND EXPENSES OF THE IMPROVEMENTS MADE IN SAID DISTRICT: PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF THE DISTRICT: ASSESSING THE COST OF THE SAID IMPROVEMENT AGAINST THE LOTS, BLOCKS AND PARCELS OF LAND IN SAID DISTRICT CONTIGUOUS OR ADJACENT TO, FRONTING OR ABUTTING UPON SAID IMPROVEMENTS AND PRESCRIBING THE MANNER FOR THE COLLECTION AND PAYMENT OF SAID ASSESSMENTS" was read in full by the Clerk.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance be passed on it first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Wing, seconded by Fanning, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 516 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Claim of the State of Idaho, Department of Reclamation for \$457.00 covering proof of completion of works for permit No. 18271 for 1500 cubic feet per second of water from Snake River was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Fanning, that the claim be referred to the City Attorney for an opinion as to the legality of the claim, and also to obtain an opinion from the Attorney General of the State of Idaho. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
