The following letter was read:

"Idaho Falls, Idaho, January 6, 1939.

Hon. Mayor and Members of the City Council
Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Gentlemen:

JANUARY 6, 1939

I am herewith submitting to you a claim in and on behalf of John Simpson and his wife, Sarah, the parents of John Ralph Simpson, a minor of 11 years of age.

It appears that on or about August 27th, 1938, that the said minor became possessed of a dynamite cap, carelessly left by certain laborers of the City employed in the construction of a water line near Highland Park, and while the said dynamite cap was in the possession of the said minor, the same became discharged and with the following results:

That the said minor suffered the partial loss of two fingers; that portions of the flesh from the leg were blown away, leaving now an unhealed wound; that the said minor was confined to a hospital for a period of two weeks, and from the moment of the accident he has suffered, and is still suffering, physical pain from said injury.

I am also informed by the parents of the minor that because of the said injuries, he is now unable to attend school, and has only spent approximately ten weeks in school since the opening of the fall term.

It is felt by the parents of the minor that he has been so injured, and has suffered physical pain to such an extent, that his damages would total not less than \$1,000.00. Therefore, I am herewith submitting to as the attorney for the said parents a claim for said sum.

Will you not kindly advise me at your earliest convenience the attitude of your Honorable Body as to the matter of a settlement.
