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Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held December 16<sup>th</sup>, 1938, and recessed until December 19, 1938, and again recessed until December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1938.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the bid of R. H. & S. B. Gardner for \$2080.00 be accepted, as this being the lowest bid, and must be accepted under P. W. A. rules and regulations, also providing R. H. and S. B. Gardner furnish a 100% bond covering total amount of bid by noon tomorrow, and in case Gardners do not provide bond, then the contract be awarded to J. W. Brennan for \$2,200.00 this being the next lowest bid. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The following resolution was read:

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT.**

WHEREAS, bids received for the construction of Addition to Library at Idaho Falls, State of Idaho, have been duly opened, read and compared, and it appears the R. H. and S. E. Gardner is low bidder, after taking alternate deductions none ; and,

WHEREAS, such bid is within the available funds of The City of Idaho Falls and P. W. A. grant; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a contract for the construction of said Addition to Library be and the same is hereby awarded to R. H. and S. E. Gardner for the sum of Two Thousand and Eighty and no/100 Dollars, such sum being the basic bid of said bidder Two Thousand and Eighty and no/100 Dollars (\$2080.00), less alternate deductions none totaling the sum of Two Thousand and Eighty and no/100 Dollars, provided, this award shall not be effective until the awardee shall have been notified in writing by the Architect of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, of the award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Mayor and City Clerk of said City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, be and they are hereby authorized to execute such construction contract and any other documents, agreements or instruments in connection therewith for and on behalf of said City of Idaho Falls, Idaho."

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It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Evans, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
