Recommendation:

1. That the dairy be granted to stay during the winter months of this winter or until next March 1, 1939.
2. That the corral and barn be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and the manure hauled away before more than one load accumulates.
3. That the cows be taken out March 1, 1939, and not allowed to be returned again to this location, and also that the corrals be cleaned up and manure hauled away so as to leave the corral or the lot be in a clean and sanitary condition for summer of 1939.

Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Crabtree; Motion carried.

It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase a carload of plaster for the armory and Social Aid buildings. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Crabtree; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Absent: Crabtree; Motion carried.
