The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, by its Mayor and Council, has decided to construct a water stand-pipe in the City of Idaho Falls, of 500,000 gallon capacity, and heretofore made application to the Public Works Administration of the United States of America for a forty-five percent Grant to aid in financing the construction of this water stand-pipe; and,

WHEREAS, said Public Works Administration has made said Grant and requires, as one of the conditions of the Grant, that the City make available immediately the sum of \$10,000.00 as a part of the cost of construction; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to comply with the demands of the Public Works Administration in this regard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver to the First Security Bank, Idaho Falls, Idaho, cash NOVEMBER 7, 1938

warrants of the City of Idaho Falls in the total sum of Ten Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00), to be placed on deposit in said Bank and kept in a separate account to be used in financing the construction of said water stand-pipe."

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Absent: None; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that the Meeting recess until Wednesday, November 9th, 1938, at one o'clock P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.
