Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 16th, 1938.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; when the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read:

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CHASE A. CLARK, TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR A GRANT TO AID IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER STORAGE TANK.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. That Mayor, Chase A. Clark, be and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to the Unites States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of a water storage tank."

Section 1. That Chase A. Clark, Mayor, be and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to the United States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of Power Plant Improvements.

Section 2. That C. R. Black, City Engineer, and M. P. Goudy, City Electrician, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed."

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. That Chase A Clark, Mayor, be, and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to the United States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of paving, curb and gutter, drainage structures, and other appurtenant work.

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Section 2. That C. R. Black, City Engineer, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed."

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rent for the house at the upper power plant be reduced from \$12.50 to \$7.50 per month for the operators, and the operators are to pay their light bills each month. They are to receive \$5.00 credit each month from May 1, 1938, to date to apply on their accounts. This agreement also applied to Heslop at the City Park. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Nay: None; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Evans: Nay: None.
