The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION FIXING  
MINIMUM WAGE RATES

WHEREAS, a thorough investigation has been made of the hourly wage rates which are being paid in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, which is the locality in which the proposed project (hereinafter referred to as "Project") is to be constructed by the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to employees in each trade or occupation engaged in work of a nature similar to the work to be performed in the construction of said Project, and the prevailing hourly wage rates being paid in such locality to such employees for such work has been determined by rates paid on Project Ida. 1021-R, Street Improvements, Idaho Falls, in 1937; Docket Ida. 1029-DS, School Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho: Highway Department, State of Idaho.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that the following rates for the respective trades or occupations listed below shall be and are hereby fixed as the minimum hourly wage rates and have been determined in accordance with rates prevailing for work of a similar nature in the locality in which the project is to be constructed:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be transmitted with this Resolution the substantiating data upon which the foregoing determination is based."

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the Resolutions be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Wing, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Wing, Mehlhoff, Evans; Motion carried.
