Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held July 15<sup>th</sup>, 1938.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning; Absent: Wasley and Wing; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Wasley and Wing; Motion carried.

Lease Agreement No. 8790, covering overhead guy wire crossing with Oregon Short Line Railroad Company was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Fanning, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wasley and Wing; Motion carried.

W. P. A. Project Agreement No. 2361 covering curbs, gutters, and sidewalks was read. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be authorized to sign the project application. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wing & Wasley; Motion carried.

W. P. A. Project No. 1241 for a National Youth Administration work project was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be authorized to sign the project application. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans; Absent: Wing and Wasley; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

Gentlemen:

I refer to your letter of June 1<sup>st</sup>, to Mr. Pidcock requesting easement over a portion of railroad company property in vicinity of stockyard for sewer pipe line.

This is to advise you that our usual agreement is now being prepared to cover sewer line encroachment on outer edge of the railroad property as discussed with you by Mr. Pidcock, and I am attaching a print of our map showing location to be covered by agreement. It is desired to keep sewer line as close to outer edge of right of way as possible so as to have it out of the way of future construction.

It will be satisfactory for you to proceed with the construction of sewer line in advance of execution of agreement with the understanding that our usual agreement will be executed by the City when presented and with understanding previously agreed to that the sewer will be installed without expense to the railroad company.

Will you please let me have a letter to confirm our understanding that the City will execute contract and that there will be no expense to the railroad company.
