The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and necessary for the City of Idaho Falls to lay out and construct a public park on Lot 1, Block 61, of the Original Town Site of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof, and to acquire all of said Lot 1, Block 61, for said purpose; and,

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WHEREAS, Minor Scurlock is the owner or reputed owner of said property and the City officials have made diligent inquiry and effort to ascertain the whereabouts of said Minor Scurlock, but have been unable to locate him or ascertain his place of residence or post office address;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Attorney be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to institute and prosecute eminent domain proceedings against the owner of said Lot for the purpose of acquiring, taking, and using same for the purpose of a public park, being all of Lot 1, Block 61, of the Original Town Site of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said land hereinbefore described is necessary for the public use as hereinbefore set forth and is hereby appropriated and dedicated to the public use, to wit, as a site for the construction of a public park as hereinbefore set forth for the use of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and its inhabitants."

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase transformers and wire for the Electric Light Department, the estimate cost to be about \$1000.00. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.
