Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 1st, 1938.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans and Wing; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting and of Special Meeting held March 21st, 1938, were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Superintendent, Chief of Fire Department, Sanitary Inspector, Police Judge, Street & Park Commissioner.
