Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held March 4th, 1938.

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Superintendent, Police Judge, Sanitary Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, Street and Park Commissioner. Also ten month report of Chief of Police.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wing, that the request be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, “AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF WEST 20TH STREET IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF WALLACE BURNS,” was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

R. B. Ewart appeared before the Council and entered a protest to the closing of a portion of West Twentieth Street for Wallace Burns and to the passing of the above Ordinance as he was the owner of property across the street. The matter was referred to the Street & Alley Committee for investigation.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign an extension agreement for one year with the Federal Power Commission covering filing on Mesa Falls

power site. The cost for the extension to be \$100.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Councilman Gourley stated that the Light & Water Committee had inspected the new water storage tank and they recommend that the tank be accepted. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the 500,000 gallon water storage tank constructed by the Chicago Bridge & Iron Company be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Contract for advertising space in Special Vacationland Edition of Seeing Idaho Magazine was presented to the Council. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the advertising agreement covering double page in May, 1938, issue of Seeing Idaho Magazine, total cost to be \$450.00. Voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.
