Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held February 4th, 1938.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Gourley and Sutton; when the following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Superintendent, Police Judge, Sanitary Inspector, Street & Park Commissioner, Chief of Fire Department.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the claim be rejected as Mr. Jacoby was paid for the full month of May, 1937, when he was still employed at the High School and he did not work for the City after August 16th, 1937. The Mayor stated that at the time the City purchased the West Side Power Company transmission line, it was agreed by the attorneys that all stockholders in this company still receive 10% discount on their electric light bills from the City of Idaho Falls. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Wasley, that the property owners connected with the West Side Power Company receive

their regular 10% discount on their electric bills as per agreement with the City at the time the City purchased their power line. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Nay: None; Absent: Gourley and Sutton; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the work done by firemen on toys in the shop is part of their regular duties. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley and Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley and Sutton; Motion carried.
