An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 255 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, PROVIDING FOR LICENSING ROLLER SKATING RINKS AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THE LICENSE FEE THEREFORE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Nay: None; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 511 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

At this time Councilman Sutton entered the Meeting.

The Mayor requested authority from the Council to sign application for W. P. A. Project and to ratify the application for \$30,000.00 for a W. P. A. Sewer Project signed by the Mayor about January 3rd, 1938. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the application for \$30,000.00 for a W. P. A. Sewer Project signed by the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be approved, and authority be given them to sign any future applications. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be authorized to sign all commitments on W. P. A. Projects with the consent of the Finance Committee. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wing, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Nay: None; Motion carried.
