

OCTOBER 15, 1937

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held October 15th, 1937.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark; Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Wing and Gourley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

Application for license to operate two taxi cabs by Hotel Rogers Cab Co. was read. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for building permit No. 1742 signed by R. M. Kunz was read. The Mayor referred the permit to the Building Committee for investigation.

The following applications for building permits were read:

- No. 1740 signed by Chas. J. Coughlin
- No. 1741 signed by F. M. Hollibaugh

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

Gentlemen:

At a recent meeting of the Retail Merchants, considerable complaint was brought out on the 5 minute parking zones.

It was decided that a suggestion can not be seen, it was suggested that a metal sign be erected on the sidewalk which would be seen by the motoring public and that also a 10 minute limit be put on these zones instead of the present 5 minutes.

OCTOBER 15, 1937

An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 505 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, WHICH PROVIDED THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN (16) YEARS TO BE ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, OR ANY UNOCCUPIED PLACE AFTER NINE O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning; Nay: None; Absent: Gourley and Wing; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 473 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PROHIBITING THE SALE AND SERVING OF BEER AND OTHER BEVERAGES CONTAINING ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT OR MORE OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME. BETWEEN THE HOURS OF TWO A.M. AND SIX O'CLOCK A.M., AND REGULATING THE SALE AND SERVING OF SUCH BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF: was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning; Nay: None; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

The Mayor requested authority for the City Clerk to purchase one warrant for \$5000.00 and one warrant for \$8685.00 which were issued to the Chicago Bridge & Iron Company out of the Meter Deposit account. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Evans, that two warrants issued to the Chicago Bridge & Iron Company, one for \$5000.00 and one for \$8685.00 be purchased by the City Clerk out of the Meter Deposit account and just as soon as the Electric Light Fund has the money the warrants are to be paid back to the meter investment account. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor requested that a Resolution be passed to discontinue paying a collector a commission on collections of delinquent water and light accounts. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Nay: None; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 5th day of November, 1937.
