Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 17<sup>th</sup>, 1937.

Lease Agreement covering pole storage site on west end of Eagle Rock Street from Union Pacific Railroad Company was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Lease Agreement. The following letter was read:

“ Council:

I am writing in regard to getting water to my property. Six months ago I bought Lots 33 to 40 Block 29 on 25<sup>th</sup> Blvd. I have built a house on them and we are living there and wish to get water there. So far we have carried water from the neighbors. They tell us they don't want to be bothered after we must come in their house for water.

We don't have the time or the money to put in our own water. Anyway we don't care to take on the responsibility of digging a ditch across the Blvd. and down the middle of the road.

Could you please consider this matter at the next Council and let us know what you have decided.
