

AUGUST 20, 1937

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 20th, 1937.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing; Absent: Gourley and Crabtree; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Fanning, that \$300.00 be transferred from the General Fund to Jessie M. Hanson, Trustee, to pay the City's portion of paving on Emerson Avenue between 9th and 10th Streets. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Gourley and Crabtree; Motion carried.

Extension Rider Agreement Audit No. 18126 L. D. No. 8653 covering transmission line encroachment with Union Pacific Railroad Company from October 20, 1937 to October 20, 1942, was read. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE 417 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 451 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON MONEY DEPOSITED WITH THE CITY FOR ELECTRIC METERS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Nay: None; Absent: Gourley and Crabtree; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Sutton, seconded by Fanning, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing; Nay: None; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion passed. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Evans, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning; Nay: None; Absent: Gourley and Crabtree; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 505 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE STREET LYING BETWEEN LOTS 11 AND 12 OF BLOCK 21 OF WINN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS AND THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 5, SECTION AUGUST 20, 1937

24, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 37 EAST BOISE MERIDIAN, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE AS PROVIDED BY LAW" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning; Nay: None; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Evans, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff; Nay: None; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Wing, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Wing, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Nay: None; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 506 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Fanning, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Wing, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried.
