The following claim was read:

Salary for June, 1937 \$25.00”

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the claim be allowed, and an additional amount of \$70.00 be paid during the summer, \$60.00 for two months salary, and \$10.00 for supplies. Bids on Lots 10, 11, and 12 in Block 62 Old Townsite by Idaho Falls Chamber of Commerce for \$1.00 was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the bid be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.

The monthly report of the Police Judge for the money of June, 1937, was read and approved.

Lease Agreement for Caterpillar Tractor from the Westmont Tractor and Equipment Co. for a purchase price of \$4280.00 to be paid on a rental basis was read. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Evans, that the lease be referred to the Park & Finance Committee with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to order steel for the new roof at Power Plant No. 1, and the City Electrician furnish the necessary estimates for the steel to the Purchasing Agent. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Fanning, that the Updike house on Memorial Drive be advertised for sale. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wing, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.
