

JANUARY 8, 1937

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 8, 1937.

There were present at said Meeting: R. B. Ewart, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Fanning, Crowley; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Councilman Edward W. Fanning took the oath of office as Councilman from the third ward, said oath being administered by Lee Walker, City Clerk.

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting and of a Special Meeting held December 30th, 1936, were read and approved.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the Ordinance Committee prepare an Ordinance to amend Section 51 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Idaho Falls, authorizing the City Clerk to invest meter deposit money in electric meters as an investment when directed by the Mayor and City Council. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Gourley and Crabtree; Motion carried.

The following monthly reports were read: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Superintendent, Sanitary Inspector, Street and Park Commissioner, Chief of Fire Department.

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Ed Carney, Bonneville County noxious weed supervisor under the W. P. A. presented the Council with a check for \$500.00, being the amount the City put up last spring as their share of the weed control revolving fund. Mr. Carney stated that all of the projects bills were paid, and they had a very successful year, and the farmers of Bonneville County appreciate the assistance and co-operation they received from the City of Idaho Falls.

Councilman Evans stated that the W. P. A. under a project had made frames for garbage racks and the engineer requests that the City furnish bolts for the racks. It was moved by Wilkie that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase bolts for W. P. A. garbage racks. Motion lost, there being no second.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Fanning, that the Purchasing Agent get the cost of furnishing bolts for the W. P. A. garbage racks, and report at the next Regular Meeting. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Wing, Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crabtree and Gourley; Motion carried.
