Triple combination Pumping Fire Engine with all equipment and extras from the Seagrave Corporation for \$9200.00 less 5% for cash within thirty days, making a net amount of \$8740.00 F. O. B. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE FROM GOING IN AND UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, NOT HAVING BEEN REQUESTED OR INVITED SO TO DO BY THE OWNER OR OWNERS, OCCUPANT, OCCUPANTS, OF SAID PRIVATE RESIDENCES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SOLICITING ORDERS FOR THE SALE OF GOODS, WARES, AND MERCHANDISE, AND/OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSING OF AND/OR PEDDLING OR HAWKING THE SAME; DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A NUISANCE AND DESCRIBING THE PUNISHMENT THEREFORE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be placed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk, and it was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the Ordinance be placed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Ordinance be placed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 504 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, is the owner of the following described real property:

Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11), and Twelve (12), in Block Sixty-two (62) of the Original Townsite of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho ,

WHEREAS, said property was not acquired or used as a public park, playground, or public building site and is not needed for municipal purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said property be offered for sale at private sale and that the Clerk publish notice of intention to sell said property as provided by law."

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Gourley, that the Resolution be adopted and approved, and notice of sale be published once each week, for two successive weeks in the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls. Mr. Hobson addressed the Council and requested the City to buy two pages of advertising in the Seeing Idaho Magazine at a rate of \$500.00 for one issue. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the proposition be rejected at this time. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.

M. P. Goudy, City Electrician, requested authority for the Purchasing Agent to purchase a new International truck and body for the Electric Light Department at a price of \$2751.59 F. O. B. factory. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the matter be referred to the Light & Water Committee with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting recess until Friday, June 25th, 1937. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Wasley; Motion carried.
