

JUNE 8, 1937

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 4th, 1937, and recessed until June 8th, 1937.

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1937-1938 AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be placed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wing, that the Ordinance be placed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Wing, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent, Evans: Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Wing, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 503 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Crabtree, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

JUNE 8, 1937

The City Engineer stated that all of the street lighting cable on Broadway and Cottage Avenue should be replaced before the State puts in the new curb. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase 4000 feet of street lighting cable from the Wallace General Cable Corp. at a price of \$932.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

License Agreement covering the privilege of setting three poles on the Municipal Airport ground by the Department of Commerce was read. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

Service Agreement from May 1st, 1937, to April 30th, 1939, at a rate of \$50.00 per month on neon signs around top of City Building to be serviced by the Electrical Products Consolidated, was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Service Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

The Mayor requested authority for the City Attorney to file condemnation suit against the Montana Power Company for the land at Mesa Falls power site necessary for a tunnel and transmission lines. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

The Mayor stated that there may be some delay in the power development program, and he would recommend that the City build a 500,000 gallon water storage tank. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

Councilman Wasley stated that members of the Fifth Ward of the L. D. S. Church were digging a basement for their new church and request the City to install two spot lights so that the members can work at night. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Electric Light Department install two flood lights for the L. D. S. Fifth Ward on Second Street so that men can work on the basement at nights. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

C. W. Mehlhoff addressed the Council and requested the City to vacate the alley between Short Street and Chamberlain Avenue. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the City Attorney prepare an Ordinance and quitclaim deed to vacate part of alley between Chamberlain Avenue and Short Street, providing E. E. Price will sign a release for his property. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

A. W. Rates appeared before the Council and requested the City to enlarge the water service line to his property South of the City. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the matter be referred to the Water & Light Committee. Roll call voting Aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Absent: Evans; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 18th day of June, 1937.
