The new Mayor and City Councilmen took the official oath of office and were sworn in by the City Clerk.

The Mayor then called the new Council into session, when the following proceedings took place, to-wit:

There were present at said Meeting: Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; when the following Resolution was presented and read:

RESOLUTION

“WHEREAS, Mayor R. E. Ewart and Councilmen Worth D. Wright, Stanley Crowley and A. H. Wilkie, have long and faithfully served the City of Idaho Falls and have given their time and sincere efforts to the up-building of the City and to the promotion of the welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the City Officials express and show its appreciation for these services;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, that the Mayor and City Council in behalf of the City of Idaho Falls, do hereby express and declare their sincere thanks and appreciation to Mayor R. B. Ewart, Councilmen Worth D. Wright, Stanley Crowley, and A. H. Wilkie for their splendid services to the City of Idaho Falls and its people, and that this Resolution be entered in full upon the City records.”

I propose to Audit the books of the City of Idaho Falls for the period from May 1, 1937 to April 30, 1939, on the following terms:

The Audit of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, shall be performed in accordance with the Uniform Specifications for Audit of all incorporated cities and villages, as adopted by the Bureau of Public Accounts as of November 1, 1936, and subsequent amendments and Audit shall be completed within 90 days after close of the Fiscal Year period.

My fees, subject to the existing statutes of Idaho pertaining to incorporated city and/or village Audits, will be payable upon approval by the Council or Board of Trustees of the reports at the rate of \$850.00 for each Fiscal Year.
