RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, from the official returns and the canvass made thereof by the City Council, it appears that Chase A. Clark received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor, and that Lee Walker received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Clerk, and that Jessie M. Hanson, received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Treasurer; and that Gradie S. Evans and Thomas L. Sutton received the majorities of votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the First Ward; that Ray Crabtree and John T. Wing received the majorities of votes cast for the offices of Councilmen from the Second Ward, and that E. W. Fanning and F. William Gourley received the majorities of the votes cast for the offices of Councilmen for the Third Ward, and that Peter Mehlhoff and T. C. Wasley received the majorities of the votes cast for the offices of Councilmen of the Fourth Ward of said City:
