Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 16th, 1937.

Application for building permit No. 1566 signed by Charles Packwich was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wright, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Fanning, Wright; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; Nay: Evans; Motion carried.

Applications for water extension signed by Rose Ernst, Anton Ernst and James Allen were read. The Mayor referred the applications to the Water and Light Committee.

The Mayor appointed L. G. Jackson as Chief of the Fire Department. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Wilkie, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Fanning, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; Motion carried.
