The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, is the owner of the following described property:

Beginning at a point in the Southeast corner of Lot 17, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, and running thence North along the East line of said Lot 17, South 36 degrees 25' West along the easterly line of said Yellowstone Highway, 84.1 feet to the West line of Lot 18; thence South along the West line of said Lot 18, 40.6 feet to the Southwest corner of said Lot 18, said point being in the South line of the North half of Block 12; thence East along the South line of said North half of Block 12, 50.0 feet to the point of beginning, and comprising a portion of Lots 17 and 18, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition.

The South 4 feet of Lot 1, Block 1, Anderson Subdivision of Block 77, Original Townsite Addition to the City of Idaho Falls.

Beginning at a point in the South line of the North half of Block 5, Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho; said point being the Southeast corner of Lot 7, and running thence North along the East line of said Lot 7, 122.6 feet to the Easterly line of the Yellowstone Highway; thence South 36 degrees, 25' West along the Easterly line of said Yellowstone Highway, 152.3 feet to the South line of the North half of Block 5, thence East along the South line of said North half of Block 5, 90.6 feet to the point of beginning and comprising part of Lots 7, 8, 9, and 10, Block 5, Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls.

WHEREAS, said property was not acquired or used as a public park, playground or public building site and is not needed for municipal purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said property be offered for sale at private sale and that the Clerk publish notice of intention to sell said property as provided by law. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wilkie, that the Resolution be adopted. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Gourley, Fanning; Absent: Evans and Wing; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wilkie, that the re-plat of Bremer Construction Company on Block 31 and Lots 29 to 48, inclusive, of Block 24, South Park Addition be approved, subject to approval of the City Attorney. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Gourley, Fanning, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans and Wing; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Crowley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to ask for bids on a 500,000 gallon water storage tank, and also a new turbine for Unit No. 4 at Power Plant No. 1. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Gourley, Fanning, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Wing and Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Gourley, that the Meeting recess until March 29<sup>th</sup>, 1937. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Gourley, Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Wilkie; Absent: Wing and Evans; Motion carried.
