An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THE CITY CLERK SHALL KEEP AN ACCOUNT OF ALL ELECTRIC METER DEPOSITS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE CUSTODY, CONTROL AND INVESTMENT OF SUCH METER DEPOSIT FUND" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Fanning, Wright; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Fanning, Wright, Evans; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Fanning, Wright, Evans, Wilkie;

Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final readings, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Fanning,

Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 498 and passed to the Mayor for is approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Councilman Gourley stated that the sewer on Park Avenue should be connected onto the storm sewer. The Mayor stated that the sewer on 13th Street & Emerson Avenue should be improved so that it could take care of the water run-off in this corner. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the matter be referred to the City Engineer for investigation. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Fanning, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.
