

JANUARY 15, 1937

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 15th, 1937.

There were present at said Meeting: R. B. Ewart, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Wing and Gourley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following claim was read:

“STATE OF IDAHO, DEPT. OF RECLAMATION

To filing fee application on Anderson Dam site; 1000 C. F. S.; \$254.75”

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Fanning, that the claim be allowed. Roll call voting Aye: Fanning, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley and Wing; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed Councilman Fanning as Chairman of the Police Committee, and Councilman Wilkie as Chairman of the Light & Water Committee, and Councilman Fanning to act on the Building and Fire Committee.

Councilman Wright stated that one of the street flushers was completely worn out and the necessary repairs would cost about \$1500.00 to put this flusher in first class condition for spring use. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the matter be referred to the Street and Alley and Finance Committees with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Fanning; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that most cities of first and second class in Idaho belonged to the Idaho Municipal Officers Association, and the annual dues were \$15.00. He stated that valuable information can be obtained by public officials from the Association. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the City of Idaho Falls join the Idaho Municipal Officers Association. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Fanning, Crowley; Absent: Wing and Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wilkie, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Fanning, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Gourley and Wing; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 5th day of February, 1937.
