The following resignation was read:

Gentlemen:

It is with mingled feelings of pride and regret that I hereby tender my resignation as Mayor of the City of Idaho Falls.

During this term of office we have seen the output of our municipal hydro-electric plants increased by 100%; we have built up a municipal service which not only has the

unanimous support of our own citizens, but is cited in other parts of our state and of the northwest as an outstanding community effort.

Some of you have served all during my own incumbency. Whether we have always agreed, or have disagreed, I am not wishing you an easy task or perpetual harmony, but I trust you will continue to have an earnest purpose, and that your labors will help promote continued progress for this community.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wright, that Councilman Ewart be elected Mayor for the balance of the term ending April 30th, 1937. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree.

The City Council elected Councilman Crowley as President of the City Council.

The Mayor appointed Edward W. Fanning as Councilman from the third ward. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the appointment be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 8th day of January, 1937.
