

NOVEMBER 13, 1936

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held November 6th, 1936, and recessed until November 13th, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ASSESSMENT ROLL
OF
LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Committee on Streets have heretofore made out and certified to the City Council, as provided by law, an assessment roll of Local Improvement District No. 17; and,

WHEREAS, on October 20, 1936, the City Council fixed the time and place when and where objections to said assessment roll by the property owners of said District would be heard, to wit, Friday, the 6th day of November, 1936, at eight o'clock P.M. of said day, at the Council Chambers in the City Building at Idaho Falls, Idaho; and,

WHEREAS, notice was duly and regularly given as provided by law by the Clerk of the time to file objections to said assessment roll; and,

WHEREAS, said hearing was continued and adjourned until Friday, the 13th day of November, 1936, at eight o'clock P.M. at said Council Chambers in the City Building, at Idaho Falls, Idaho; and,

WHEREAS, no objections were filed or made to said assessment roll, excepting only the objection of the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, which objections has since been withdrawn; and,

WHEREAS, the Council has examined said assessment roll and finds that the amount levied on each lot or parcel of land is correct, just and equitable, and that said assessment roll is in all respects true and correct;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that said assessment roll, and each and every item thereof, and the whole thereof, be, and the same hereby is in all respects approved and confirmed.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wing, that water extension be put in Block 8 of Brodbeck's Addition on East 18th Street for the following applicants: R. M. Butter, Fla Engberson, Charles M. Butter, A. B. McCowin, Sam Ellingford, Lora Butter, providing that the applicants dig and backfill the trench. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart that the City Council reconsider the application for building permit granted to Leo Loble to construct a factory for the manufacture of cattle and poultry feeds and hides and tallow. Motion lost, there being no second.

NOVEMBER 13, 1936

Councilman Crowley stated that the Finance & Building & Fire Committee had gone into the matter of purchasing a new fire truck and they found the old truck could be repaired very reasonably, and as there is no provision in the present budget, they would recommend that the matter be deferred. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the matter of purchasing a new fire truck be deferred until the next fiscal year. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

E. V. Davis appeared before the Council as agent for M. G. Zellers of Pocatello and stated that Mr. Zellers would like a franchise to operate a bus line in Idaho Falls. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Gourley, that the Council look with favor on the proposition. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wing, that the claim of C. E. Bridges for \$88.00 for digging water trench to his property on First Street be allowed. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Wing, Ewart; Nay: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Gourley; Absent: Crowley; Motion lost.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 13th day of November, 1936.
