

OCTOBER 16, 1936

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held October 16th, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Wright, Evans; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wing, that the said building permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; Motion carried.

The following petition for water extension was read:

The Acting Mayor referred the petition to the Water Committee.

It was moved by Wilkie, that the claim be allowed and when paid applied on C. E. Bridges water and light account. Motion lost, No second. The acting Mayor referred the claim to the City Attorney.

City Attorney Albaugh stated that the Taxicab operators have not furnished bonds as they had agreed to last week. O. A. Toone of the Yellow Cab Company stated that the operators could not find an insurance company who would write the policy according to our Ordinances. The Acting Mayor referred the matter to the Ordinance Committee and City Attorney.

Councilman Evans stated that the Carl Updike property on Memorial Drive can now be purchased on the following terms:

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wilkie, that the Updike property be purchased on Memorial Drive for \$2500.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Crowley and Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that B. M. Rogers would put in a new curb and gutters on the east side of his hotel building on Shoup Avenue for \$75.00. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the City allow B. M. Rogers \$75.00 for putting in new gutter and curb on Shoup Avenue east of his new building. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that a new shoe and some other parts should be purchased for the snow plow tractor before Winter. The cost of repairs would be about \$750.00 and the County Commissioners had refused to pay any part of the expense. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the City stand the expense, and repair the County and City snow plow tractor before Winter. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Wright; Absent: Gourley and Crowley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 7th day of November, 1936.
