Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans; Absent: Wilkie and Crowley; Motion carried.

The following claim, was read: Charley Smith, for \$56.00 for services rendered as pipe man from September 23<sup>rd</sup> to October 4<sup>th</sup>, 1936, this amount having been deducted from salary for sickness. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the claim be paid. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans; Absent: Wilkie and Crowley; Motion carried.

The following application for water extension was read:

The Acting Mayor referred the application to the Water and Light Committee.

The following bid to purchase Local Improvement District No. 17 bonds was opened and read:

Gentlemen:

In compliance with your Notice of Sale inviting bids for approximately \$35,000 improvement bonds of Local Improvement District No. 17 in and for Idaho Falls, bearing interest at the rate of four percent (4%) per annum, payable annually, which bond shall be payable in ten (10) equal installments.

We bid par and accrued interest for said bonds, with the understanding that the City of Idaho Falls retains or purchases \$3000 bonds of the latest maturities and the latest numbers.

Enclosed is a certified check equal to five percent (5%) of the bid, payable to the order of the City Treasurer, drawn on the First Security Bank, Idaho Falls, which is to be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages if we fail to take up and pay for the bonds when presented.

If our bid, which is for immediate acceptance only, is rejected, you agree to promptly return our check. If our bid is accepted, the deposit is to be applied as part payment on the bonds when they are delivered to us in accordance with the terms of our bid.

Chairman Crabtree of the Committee appointed to investigate the J. L. Grimmett carpenter shop or planing mill on Lee Avenue and 15<sup>th</sup> Street reports that the Committee found a modern planing mill on a small scale located in the building and his Committee recommends its removal and the Building Zoning Ordinance be enforced. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wright, that J. L. Grimmett be given written notice by the City Attorney that his planing mill and carpenter shop must be moved from Lee Avenue and 15<sup>th</sup> Street within sixty days. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Nay: Evans; Absent: Crowley and Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley and Wilkie; Motion carried.
