

SEPTEMBER 25, 1936

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 18th, 1936, recessed until September 24th, 1936, and recessed until September 25th, 1939.

The Meeting was called to order by the Chairman and on roll call the following were absent: Mayor Barzilla W. Clark and Councilman Wilkie.

After discussion the following Resolution was offered:

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Idaho Falls, that:

Whereas, bids for street improvements, Special Improvement District #17, Idaho Falls, Idaho, in connection with P.W.A. Docket No. Ida-1021R were received and opened on the 24th day of September, and in the opinion of the Board the bid submitted by Morrison-Knudsen Co., Inc. was and is the lowest and best bid so submitted:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the sense of the City Council that the bid of the said Morrison-Knudsen Co. should be accepted and it is so recommended. This recommendation is based upon the report and recommendation of applicant's architect, whose report and recommendation dated September 24th, 1936, are by reference made a part hereof. It was moved by Wright that the bid of Morrison-Knudsen, Inc., of \$74,178.80 be accepted subject to the approval of the P.W.A.

The above Resolution was seconded by Crabtree, was adopted with the following voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Wilkie; and the following voting Nay: None.

The Chairman thereupon declared said Resolution duly carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Crabtree, that two weeks be granted regular City Employees for sick leave. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wing, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Wilkie; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 2nd day of October, 1936.
