

SEPTEMBER 18, 1936

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 18th, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen: Crabtree, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Councilmen Wilkie, Wing, Gourley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

Councilman Crowley presented bid of Mrs. R. B. Schick for \$450.00 for the Collette House on Memorial Drive. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the Finance Committee be authorized to accept the offer of \$450.00 for the Collette House on Memorial Drive. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans; Absent: Wing, Gourley and Wilkie; Motion carried.

The following Resolution of condolence was read:

“Whereas Almighty God has called from her duties and from our company and association a beloved member of our community, Mrs. Eunice Hadley Clark, at the age of 89 years, affectionately known as Mother Clark; and,

Whereas, Eunice Hadley Clark lived a long and useful life among us as a loving wife, tender mother and Christian woman, devoting herself actively to all temperance, cultural and church purposes, closely connected with school and church construction, and a member of the Presbyterian Church, always cheerful, helpful and freely giving of advice and assistance wherever needed. Her only weakness was her unswerving loyalty to her conception of service to her God and mankind. In the passing of Mother Clark we have lost a valued member of our community, a wise counselor, a local friend and a pious Christian.

Therefore, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, in Special Meeting assembled this 18th day of September, 1936, that our expression of profound regret be recorded, and sincerest condolences and sympathy be extended to Honorable Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor of the City of Idaho Falls, and to the other surviving sons and daughters of Mother Clark, and that a copy of this Resolution be delivered to the family, a copy given to the press, and a copy spread upon the Clerk’s minutes of the City of Idaho Falls.”

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting recess until next Thursday evening at eight o’clock P.M., September 24th, 1936. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Crabtree; Absent: Gourley, Wilkie and Wing; Motion carried.
