

SEPTEMBER 4, 1936

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 4th, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Gourley, Evans, Wilkie; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting and of a Special Meeting held August 28th, 1936, were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Water Works Superintendent; Sanitary Inspector; Street and Park Commissioner; Chief of Fire Department.

At this time, B. M. Rogers, L. M. Earl and George Brunt entered protests to a proposed Ordinance by the Chamber of Commerce which would require an Itinerant Merchant to put up a surety bond or a cash bond of \$1,000.00 before he could start up a new business. After considerable discussion there was no action taken by the Council.

The following bids on house located on Memorial Drive, which was advertised for sale, were opened and read:

The Mayor referred the bids to the Finance Committee with power to act.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley, Evans, Wilkie; Motion carried.

The following applications for water extensions were read: Mrs. Zelda Egbert, et al., M & M and Idaho Falls Fur Farm, Inc. The Mayor referred the applications to the Water & Light Committee.

Extension Rider Agreement between the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company and City of Idaho Falls covering pump in subway and purchase of electrical power were read. It was moved by **SEPTEMBER 4, 1936**

Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Extension Agreements. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart; Absent: Evans, Wilkie and Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the bid of \$75.00 made by Idaho Falls Livestock Commission Company on August 21st, 1936, for parts of Lots 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, and 43 in Block 4, and parts of Lots 12, 13, 14, and 15, and parts of Lots 30, 31, 32, and 33, in Block 5, Capitol Hill Addition be accepted and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to issue and sign a quitclaim deed for same when parts of Lots are paid for. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Absent: Evans, Wilkie, and Gourley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that portions of Lots 24, 25 and 26, in Block 16 in Mayflower Addition, being west of Yellowstone Highway, be advertised for sale. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans, Wilkie and Gourley; Motion carried.

Councilman Gourley entered the Meeting at this time and participated in the proceedings.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST AND EXPENSES OF CREATING LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17 IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND OF MAKING LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN, EXCLUSIVE OF THE COST AND EXPENSES OF IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN STREET INTERSECTIONS, BY INSTALLMENTS PAYABLE IN TEN EQUAL ANNUAL PAYMENTS AS NEARLY AS MAY BE, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN THE NAME OF SAID MUNICIPALITY FOR SAID INSTALLMENTS, AND FIXING THE RATE OF INTEREST THEY SHALL BEAR, AND MAKING THE SAME PAYABLE ANNUALLY, AND PROVIDING THAT BONDS SHALL NOT BE ISSUED IN EXCESS OF FIFTY-FIVE PER CENT (55%) OF THE CONTRACT PRICE AND THE COST AND EXPENSES OF MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENTS, AND PROVIDING HOW AND BY WHOM CONTRACT FOR MAKING SAID IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE MADE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wing, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Wilkie and Evans; Motion carried. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crowley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second, third and final readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Crowley, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Evans, and Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 493 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly

signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

SEPTEMBER 4, 1936

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the City Clerk be authorized to prepare a notice and have same published in one issue each week for three consecutive weeks in the Post Register to advertise sale of Bonds for Special Improvement District No. 17. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Gourley, that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for improvements contemplated under P. W. A. Docket Idaho 1021R, Street Improvements, Idaho Falls, Idaho. Said notice calling for bids to be published in the Post Register once each week for three consecutive weeks September 6th, 13th, and 20th, 1936. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Evans, and Wilkie; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crowley, that the Mayor and City Clerk enter into a contract with the City Engineer and the City Attorney, to perform their respective duties in connection with Special Improvement District No. 17, at the salaries specified in the 1936-1937 Budget. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled: "ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO PARK A MOTOR VEHICLE IN CERTAIN ALLEYS IN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF IDAHO FALLS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wright, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans, and Wilkie; Motion carried. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Ewart, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second, third and final readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley; Wright; Absent: Wilkie and Evans; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance pass on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wing, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 494 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance covering the license and bonds of Taxicab operators be referred to the City Attorney and Ordinance Committee for revising. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried.

SEPTEMBER 4, 1936

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Meeting recess until Tuesday, September 8th, 1936, at 8 P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Evans and Wilkie; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 18th day of September, 1936.
