A Special Meeting of the City Council of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held pursuant to the preceding call of three members of the Council, was held on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1936.

The Meeting was called to order by the Mayor, and on roll call the following answered present: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley.

After discussion of the offer of the United States of America to aid by way of grant in financing the grading, gravelling, prime coating, tack coating, paving and surface draining certain streets and parts of streets within Special Improvement District No. 17 within said City, the following Resolution numbered 1 and entitled "A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, TO AID BY THE WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS IN SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17" was proposed by Worth D. Wright and read in full as follows:

"A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho:

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**Section 1.** That the offer of the United States of America to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to aid by way of a grant in financing the improvement of certain streets and parts of streets in Special Improvement District No. 17 of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, which offer reads as follows:

'P.W. 60012-31 FEDERAL EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC WORKS. Washington, D. C. Dated August 20, 1936. Docket No. Idaho 1021-R. City of Idaho Falls, Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

1. Subject to the rules and regulations (PWA Form No. 179, as amended to date) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of street improvements (herein called the "Project") by making a grant to the City of Idaho Falls in the amount of 45 percent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$34,118.

2. This offer is conditioned upon the applicant's submitting evidence satisfactory to the Administrator that it has completed the creation of Local Improvement District No. 17 for the City of Idaho Falls in accordance with all applicable local and state laws prior to the time that construction is authorized.

**Section 2.** That said City of Idaho Falls agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations relating to such grant, a copy of which Rules and Regulations were annexed to the Government's offer and made a part thereof.

**Section 3.** It is hereby covenanted that work on the Project described in the offer will be commenced by October 1, 1936; that the work will be planned so that it will reach a substantial peak before January 1, 1937, and that the Project will be completed by October 1, 1937.

**Section 4.** That the City Clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works three certified copies of this Resolution and three certified copies of the proceedings of this Council in connection with the adoption of this Resolution and such further documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works.
