

AUGUST 21, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 21st, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Crowley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read:

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Don Kugler addressed the Council as President of the Chamber of Commerce, and requested that the City change the present Itinerant Merchant license to a bond of \$1000.00 per year. The Mayor referred the matter to the Ordinance Committee.

August Johnson, President of the West Side Power Company, addressed the Council and requested that the City furnish all line material for all new service lines. The Mayor referred the rural electric light requests to the Electric Light & Water Committee.

An Agreement with the Iowa Valve Company covering the inspection and service of fire hydrants was read. The Mayor referred the agreement to the Light & Water Committee.

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The Mayor referred the bids to the Finance Committee.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO MAINTAIN OR OPERATE AN AUTOMOBILE WRECKING ESTABLISHMENT OR JUNK YARD WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, UNLESS SAID ESTABLISHMENT OR YARD IS ENCLOSED WITHIN A BUILDING OR BY A WALL, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wilkie, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Wilkie, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 491 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND SETTING FORTH THE BOUNDARIES OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17, IN AND FOR IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRADING, GRAVELING, PRIME COATING, TACK COATING, PAVING, AND SURFACE DRAINING CERTAIN STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS THEREIN: PROVIDING THAT SUCH IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE MADE AND THAT THE COST AND EXPENSES OF SUCH IMPROVEMENTS, LESS AT LEAST FORTY-FIVE PER CENT THEREOF, SHALL BE TAXED AND ASSESSED UPON ALL PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT IN PROPORTION TO THE NUMBER OF SQUARE FEET OF LANDS AND LOTS ABUTTING, ADJOINING, CONTIGUOUS, AND ADJACENT THERETO INCLUDED IN SAID DISTRICT, AND IN PROPORTION TO THE BENEFITS DERIVED TO SUCH PROPERTY BY SAID IMPROVEMENTS, AND PROVIDING THAT THE WHOLE COST AND EXPENSES OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN STREET INTERSECTIONS

SHALL BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE CITY: AND PROVIDING FURTHER THAT THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS IS DEPENDENT UPON A AUGUST 21, 1936

DONATION OF NOT LESS THAN FORTY-FIVE PER CENT OF THE COST AND EXPENSES THEREOF BEING MADE BY PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT TO DEFRAY THE REMAINDER OF THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS, OTHER THAN THE TOTAL COST AND EXPENSES OF IMPROVING THAT PORTION WITHIN STREET INTERSECTIONS, AND THE SALE OF SAID BONDS AT PAR", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Wright, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Evans, seconded by Ewart, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 492 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that a street light be installed at the Northeast corner of Highland Park. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wing, seconded by Crabtree, that we reconsider the bill of Gem State Oil Company for \$67.00 for cleaning out sewer. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Wright, Crabtree, Wing; Nay: Ewart and Evans; Absent: Crowley; Pass: Wilkie; Motion lost.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wing, that the bill of \$67.00 charged to Gem State Oil Company for cleaning our sewer between C & D Streets be cancelled. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 4th day of September, 1936.
