

APRIL 17, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 17, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: None; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wing, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Dr. G. B. Crabtree addressed the Council and stated that the American Legion State Convention would be held here on August 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th, and the Legion were planning on a three day rodeo to be held on August 3rd, 4th, and 5th, 1936, for \$500.00. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Claim for \$122.58 dated March 30, 1936, signed by Mrs. Delores Oakley was read. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that the City pay Mrs. Delores Oakley \$55.00 as settlement in full for this claim. We, the undersigned Police Committee, have received information from various sources during the last week to ten days to the effect that intoxicating liquors are being sold at the Bon Villa Club, 340 Broadway, and we now have positive proof thereof. We, therefore, recommend that E. C. Rigby, proprietor or operator of said club, be cited to appear and show cause why his Beer License should not be revoked.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wilkie, that the recommendation of the Police Committee be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie; Nay: Wing; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the City Attorney prepare papers citing E. C. Rigby to appear before the City Council and show cause why his license should not be revoked.

APRIL 17, 1936

Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Nay: Wing; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that the City Engineer reports that a pipe line can be put in on 9th Street by Mrs. Hamilton's property to replace the ditch now in the Street. It was moved by Wright, seconded by Crabtree, that the City Engineer and the Superintendent of Water Works proceed to lay this pipe line, and fill in the ditch. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Councilman Crowley stated that money is being spent every day for material and labor without being authorized by the City Council and the Finance Committee. It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Wright, that before any more money is spent on W. P. A. Projects, a list of costs for material and labor must be presented to the City Council for approval. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Nay: None; Motion carried.
