

APRIL 3, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 3rd, 1936.

There were present at said Meeting: Barzilla W. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Evans, Crowley and Wright; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Water Works Superintendent, Sanitary Inspector, Street and Park Commissioner, School Nurse, Chief of Fire Department.

Application for license to Peddle Produce signed by Chas. Fredrick was read. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

The following applications for building permits were read:

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wilkie; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

W. W. Christensen, superintendent of the City Schools, requested the Council to increase the City's donation \$50.00 per month which is now being used for the swimming pool instructor. This would make the sum of \$150.00 per month in this fund and they wish to employ a full time recreational director to supervise all the playgrounds in the City. The Mayor and Council authorized Mr. Christensen to proceed with the preliminary arrangements for the playground projects. Mr. Christensen also requested authority to close one block on Water Avenue west of the Central School, so that the small children would have a safe place to play during the construction work on the Junior High building. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Wing, that the School Board be authorized to close Water Avenue from Elm to Walnut Streets during school hours each day during the balance of this school term. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wilkie, Crabtree; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 15 MAYFLOWER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, WHICH LIES WEST OF THE EAST LINE OF LOTS 14 AND 35 IN SAID BLOCK 15, AND VACATING ALL THAT PORTION OF POULSON STREET WHICH LIES WEST OF THE EAST LINE OF LOT 35, BLOCK 14, MAYFLOWER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance pass on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Absent: Crowley, Wright and Evans; Motion carried.

Claim for \$122.58 signed by Mrs. Dolores Oakley was read. The Mayor referred said claim to the Finance Committee.

The following Resolution was read:

"RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on August 3, 1935, the City of Idaho Falls entered into a written contract with The James Leffel & Co., of Springfield, Ohio, for the purchase of machinery and equipment for the City's hydro-electric plant; and,

WHEREAS, there is an unpaid balance on said contract in the sum of Ten Thousand Three Hundred Forty-seven and 75/100 Dollars; and,

WHEREAS, said balance is payable in equal monthly installments beginning July 1, 1936, with interest to pay and take up the balance due on said contract; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk has been unable to find a proper investment for said funds in interest bearing securities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be, and he hereby is authorized and instructed to pay the balance due on said contract from the funds in said meter deposit account, and the City shall pay into said meter deposit account the monthly installments on said contract, together with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, as provided in said contract."

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the Resolution be adopted. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Evans, Crowley, and Wright; Motion carried.

Councilman Ewart stated that a drag line can be purchased from the Butte & Market Lake Canal Company at Roberts for \$3,250.00. This drag line can be used to remove the rock from the tailrace at the upper power plant. The Light and Water Committee has examined this drag line and they recommend that the same be purchased. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase the drag line, and arrangements be made for payment of same in next year's budget. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crowley, Wright, Evans; Motion carried.

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the Meeting recess until next Friday, April 10, 1936. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Wilkie; Absent: Wright, Crowley and Evans; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 17th day of April, 1936.
