

JULY 17, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held July 17th, 1936.

RE: Lots 12, 13, & 14, Block 72, Original Townsite of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

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Several years ago I discussed with one or two members of your body the matter of the purchase of such property in connection with the park improvement program in the vicinity of Memorial Drive and the river front. The Deed to the City from record owner and the abstract would be needed by you in the event if you were to buy such lots from the County for the Tax bill.

I have this abstract and Deed ready to deliver and will do so for the insignificant sum of \$25.00. The title holder of the property has held title and possession for over 15 years.

Application for water extension signed by Hazel Smuin and Douglas E. Done was read.

The Mayor referred same to the Light & Water Committee.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO PARK A MOTOR VEHICLE IN CERTAIN ALLEYS OF THE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF IDAHO FALLS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" was read in full by the Clerk. The Mayor referred the Ordinance to the Police Committee.

The Electric Light & Water Committee recommend the following charge for fighting fire under the proposed water extension south of the City limits at the end of Chamberlain Avenue:

Fire Trucks	\$15.00 ea. per hour
Fire Chief	2.00 per hour
Regular Firemen	1.50 per hour
Volunteer Firemen	1.50 per hour

It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Gourley, that the matter of signing a contract with property owners south of the City limits be referred to the City Attorney and the proposed water extension for fire protection be put in and paid for by the property owners. Roll call voting Aye: Wing, Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Councilman Crowley stated that the six lots owned by the A. V. Scott Estate west of the J Street Pump house can be purchased for \$600.00. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crowley, that the Finance Committee be authorized to purchase these lots. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Gourley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crowley, seconded by Evans, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Gourley, Ewart, Crowley, Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Nay: None; Motion carried.
