Quitclaim Deed to Oregon Short Line Railroad Company conveying portions of vacated Poulsen Street and alley in Block 15 Mayflower Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, was read. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Wright, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Quitclaim Deed. Roll call voting Aye: Wright, Evans, Wilkie, Wing, Gourley, Ewart; Absent: Crabtree, Crowley; Motion carried,

The following letter was read:

“Idaho Falls, Idaho
July 3, 1936

Honorable Electric Light and Water Committee
Idaho Falls, Idaho

Gentlemen:

In the matter of providing a line for fire protection for the industries located south of the City limits at the end of Chamberlain Ave., I wish to make the following recommendation and estimate for the same.

The ten inch line from Well #3 extends at present south of Capitol Ave. to Hill Street. I would recommend that a ten inch line be extended south along Capitol Ave. to the south side of the Eagle Rock School block, thence east along the south side of this block and along the south side of Block #18 of Winn’s Addition and connect with the four inch line at the corner of Short Street and Oneida Avenue with three fire hydrants located along the line.

The estimate of the cost of this extension is as follows:

1450 lineal feet of 10" C. I. pipe @ \$1.75 per ft.	\$2537.50
1450 lineal feet of trench dug and backfilled @ .35 per ft.	750.00
3-10" x 10" x 6" C. I. tees ¼ \$28.50 each	85.50
2-10" x 10" x 4" C. I. tees @ \$28.50 each	57.00
3-6" gate valves @ \$48.80 each	146.40
3-valve boxes @ \$7.25 each	21.75
3-Fire Hydrants with Pumper connections @ \$101.00 each	<u>303.00</u>
Total	\$2901.15
