

JUNE 19, 1936

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 19th, 1936.

The Mayor referred the Petition to the Ordinance Committee with instructions to prepare an Ordinance to regulate auto wrecking grounds.

The following applications for water extensions were presented to the Council by the Light & Water Committee: P. A. Smith, Leo Wright, Chas. N. Johnson, J. G. Schaffer - 18th Street between Fife and Calkins; Virgil O. Simmons, etal., estimated cost \$616.77; Orville Murphy, etal., estimated cost \$997.47; Oscar Lundstrom, etal., estimated cost \$1147.28; William McCrary, etal., estimated cost \$667.03; C. E. Bridges, estimated cost \$220.50; Pete Pauley, estimated cost \$607.01; Jesse L. Williams, etal., estimated cost \$1879.98. It was moved by Ewart, seconded by Crabtree, that the water extensions be put under the supervision of the City Engineer and Water Works Superintendent, and the budget be adjusted to take care of the cost of construction. Roll call voting Aye: Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Wright; Absent: Gourley, Crowley, Evans; Motion carried.

Councilman Wright stated that the Collette property on Memorial Drive can be purchased now as the abstract is cleared up to date. It was moved by Wilkie, seconded by Ewart, that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee with power to act. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wing, Ewart, Wright, Wilkie; Absent: Gourley, Crowley and Evans; Motion carried.

Chas J. Upham addressed the Council representing property owners south of Hill Street & Chamberlain Ave., and stated that the owners would like to enter into a fire insurance contract with the City if the City would put in a 10" water line to their property. The Mayor referred the matter to the Electric Light and Water Committee.

It was moved by Wright, seconded by Wing, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Ewart, Wright, Wilkie, Crabtree, Wing; Absent: Gourley, Crowley and Evans; Motion carried.
